Pilgrimage to the Holy Land

September 11 – 22, 2017 Chaplain: Fr. Craig Scott

Mon 11 Sep VANCOUVER - FRANKFURT

Board your Lufthansa flight to Frankfurt and connect with another Lufthansa flight to Tel-Aviv.

Tue 12 Sep JERUSALEM [D]

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in Tel-Aviv at around 7:00pm. You will be met and transferred to your hotel at the Notre Dame in Jerusalem where you will stay for the next six nights. Dinner will be served at the hotel.

Wed 13 Sep EIN KAREM - BETHLEHEM [B,D]

Begin the day with a visit to the Israeli Museum to see the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are on display. You will also see the Second Temple scale model for an overview of Jerusalem as it was in the time of Jesus. A short drive will take you to the village of Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist, and to see the Visitation Church where Mary proclaimed her famous "Magnificat". In the afternoon, drive to Bethlehem and have Mass at the Shepherd's Fields. Above the traditional Grotto of Jesus' birth, you will visit the Nativity Church, one of the oldest Christian Churches. You will also so tour the Manger, and the Church of St. Catherine. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thu 14 Sep JERICHO – BETHANY – DEAD SEA [B,D]

This morning, drive to ancient Jericho. Visit the ruins of the ancient city which was conquered by Joshua and see an example of a sycamore tree, a tree which Zacchaeus climbed in order to catch a glimpse of Jesus, which still grows in this area. From Jericho, you will be able to view the Mt. of Temptations. You will then have a short visit in Bethany to see where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. Visit the baptismal site on the River Jordan where you can renew your baptismal vows. If there is time, you can enjoy a swim in the Dead Sea before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Fri 15 Sep JERUSALEM [B,D]

This morning you will drive to the top of the Mt. of Olives for a spectacular view of Jerusalem. You will visit the Church of Pater Noster where Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, Ascension Chapel, the site where Jesus ascended into Heaven, and then walk the "Palm Sunday Road" to Dominus Flevit, where Our Lord wept over Jerusalem. Then you will proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane to visit the Church of All nations for Mass on the Rock of Agony. In the afternoon, go to Mount Zion to visit the Upper Room, the site where Jesus celebrated the Last Supper. Last, you can pray your rosary together in the Church of Dormition, where Mary was assumed into heaven and Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, the house of Caiphas where St. Peter denied Jesus three times. Before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sat 16 Sep JERUSALEM [B,D]

This morning you will walk the Via Dolorosa, finishing prayerfully in the Church of the Holy Sepulcher where you will have Holy Mass. There you will climb Mt. Calvary and pray at the site of the crucifixion. You will venerate the site where Jesus' body was anointed, the tomb where He was buried and rose from the dead, and the Chapel f St. Helena where the true cross was found. In the Old City of Jerusalem you will go through St. Stephen's Gate to visit the Church of St. Anne, where the Blessed Virgin Mary was born. Next to this site is the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the paralytic man. You will then while in the Old City, you will also see, the Wailing Wall, and you will view the Temple Mount. Return to your hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

Sun 17 Sep JERUSALEM [B,D]

Whole day free. This evening you will enjoy a farewell dinner.

Mon 18 Sep NAZARETH - CANA - ZIPPORI - TIBERIAS [B,D]

Following breakfast, you will drive to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. In Nazareth, we will celebrate mass in the Basilica of the Annunciation, which is built over the Grotto of the Annunciation. Just behind the altar, at the Cave of the Annunciation, you will see the actual room in which Mary said yes to the angel Gabriel. A few steps away from the Basilica you can visit St. Joseph's Carpentry Shop. Then drive to visit Cana, where Jesus, at the request of Mary, performed His first miracle – changing water into wine. It was here also that He blessed marriage and raised it to the dignity of a sacrament. If you wish, you may renew your wedding vows as a lasting remembrance of this holy site. From there, continue to Ziporri to see the beautiful Mosaic including a woman's face known as the "Mona Lisa of Galilee" and a well preserved zodiac featuring Greek deities on the synagogue floor. Continue to your hotel in Tiberias where you will have dinner and stay for three nights.

Tue 19 Sep TIBERIAS [B,D]

This morning, enjoy a scenic boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and proceed to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the 'Sermon on the Mount'. Visit the Church of Peter's Primacy. Here on the shore of Galilee, Jesus appeared to the Apostles after His resurrection and confirmed Peter in the role as Vicar of Christ with the words, "Feed My sheep". The rock emerging from the center of the church is the actual table at which they ate breakfast. Proceed onto Capernaum which for three years was the center of Jesus' public ministry. Here our Lord met His first disciples Peter, Andrew, James, John and Matthew and worked many miracles. He healed Peter's mother-in-law of a fever, brought a child back to life, cured a leper, healed the centurions servant, cast out a demon from a young boy and healed all that were sick. Celebrate Mass, visit the synagogue where Jesus taught, and then drive to Tabgha the site where Jesus multiplied the Loaves and Fish and fed over 5000 people.

Wed 20 Sep MT. TABOR [B,D]

In the morning, take an excursion to the summit of Mt. Tabor, where Jesus transfigured Himself and revealed His Divine Glory to the apostles. Afternoon free.

Thu 21 Sep HAIFA - CAESAREA - TEL AVIV [B, D]

This morning, leave Tiberias and drive to the sparkling port city of Haifa to visit Stella Maris. Ascend Mt. Carmel, home of the prophets Elijah and Elisha. After Mass, continue the drive along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, capital of the ancient Roman Procurators of Judea. Here, St. Peter preached and St. Paul was imprisoned for two years. Visit the Roman Theater, Crusader's Moat, and the Byzantine Churches. Continue to Tel Aviv for dinner and overnight.

Fri 22 Sep JERUSALEM – MUNICH - VANCOUVER [B]

Today your Holy Land pilgrimage comes to an end. Transfer to the airport in Tel-Aviv to catch your flight to Munich and connecting flight to Vancouver.
