Day 01

Sep 13, Thu: VANCOUVER – PARIS

Departure for France.

Day 02

Sep 14, Fri: ARRIVE PARIS

After arrival – check into hotel and depending on flight arrival, brief orientation. (D)

Day 03

Sep 15, Sat: **PARIS**

> Half day city tour with the main sites- Champs Elysees, Eiffel Tower and Notre Dame; then after lunch time to visit Rue du Bac, the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal, which was built in 1815 and was dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. In 1830 it was privileged with the extraordinary events of the apparitions of the Blessed Virgin to Sister Catherine Labouré that marked it forever. (B,D)

Day 04

Sep 16, Sun: PARIS

Half day visit to the Louvre; in the afternoon a visit to Sacre Coeur on top of Montmartre (B,D)

Day 05

Sep 17, Mon: PARIS - NEVERS - PARAY LE MONIAL

> Morning departure and stop in Nevers, where Bernadette Soubirous spent time from 1866 to 1879, after she moved there from Lourdes; learn about her story and see her incorrupt body, preserved since her death in 1879. Then after lunch travel on to Paray le Monial; visit the Shrine which is home to the devotion to the Sacred Heart. It was here that Jesus appeared to Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690), revealing to her His Heart burning with love for man. From the apparitions grew a spirituality and great devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. After the visit,

check in at your hotel and dinner (B,D)

Day 06

PARAY LE MONIAL- LYON - LA SALETTE Sep 18, Tue:

Time for lunch in Lyon and visit to the beautiful Cathedral Fauvieres, overlooking the city – then w climb the

mountains to La Salette and settle into our accommodation there (B,D)

Day 07

Sep 19, Wed: LA SALETTE

> Feast Day of Our Lady of La Salette, we go to the Shrine of Our Lady of La Salette, visit the Basilica, join the procession etc – Our Lady appeared here to 2 shepherds in 1846 to share a message of conversion. (B,D)

Day 08

Sep 20, Thu: LA SALETTE - LE LAUS - APT - AVIGNON

> This morning we stop and in the village of Le Laus, site of the shrine of Our Lady of the Le Laus where the Virgin appeared to young shepherdess Benôite Rencurel in 1664, and she became a messenger of reconciliation. There were 54 years of apparitions of Mary, the angels and Jesus Crucified – visit the shrine church, the home of Benôite and several outdoor sites where Mary appeared. The visions were approved in 2008. Le Laus is a remarkable place of natural beauty and grace – at our next stop in Apt, we visit the Church dedicated to Ste. Anne – then we leave the Alps and travel to Avignon, seat of the Papacy between 1309 – 1377, 7 consecutive popes resided here – and we

visit the Papal Palace – check in and dinner. (B,D)

Day 09

Sep 21, Fri: AVIGNON - CARCASSONNE - LOURDES

> Morning departure and stop in the medieval city of Carcassonne, a hilltop town famous for is Citadel, watch-towers and double wall fortifications. Then we travel on to Lourdes. (B,D)

Day 10

Sep 22, Sat: **LOURDES**

> Today, spend time at the Sanctuary and visit the birthplace of St. Bernadette (family home during the time of the apparitions). Attend Mass at the Grotto where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858 – bathe in the healing waters - in the afternoon do the Way of the Cross and attend the blessing of the sick - at night you may join the evening's rosary and candlelight procession (B,D)

Day 11

Sep 23, Sun: LOURDES - LISIEUX

All day drive to Lisieux, arrive in time for dinner. (B,D)

Day 12

Sep 24, Mon: LISIEUX - CAEN/NORMANDY LANDING BEACHES - ROUEN - PARIS

Visit the town of St. Therese whom Pope Pius X called "the greatest saint of modern times". Her extraordinary love for God and service to humanity comes alive as you visit the Basilica of Saint Therese, one of the biggest and most magnificent religious structures built in the 20th century. Stop as Les Buissonets, St. Therese's family home, there on display are relics, clothing, and personal objects belonging to the "little flower". Visit the ancient Cathedral of St. Peter and the Carmelite Convent. Then visit to Caen / Abbaye aux Hommes (William the Conqueror) and the Landing Beaches from 1944, Juno Beach and the memorial, etc – then travel via Rouen (stop for a coffee and a visit to the site where Jean of Arc was burnt at stake) – and end the day in Paris area in time for dinner. (B,D)

Day 13

Sep 25, Tue: PARIS – VANCOUVER

Transfer to airport for your flight home. (B)
